Later, inspiration is everywhere – a friend, a daughter or daughter-in-law, and the list goes on. The reality is: everyone has a SHERo who has positively impacted their life.

Honor your SHERo

Greenville Women Giving has created a way for its supporters to honor the women who have encouraged and inspired them, through a contribution to the GWG Endowment. The Endowment was established at the culmination of GWG’s Tenth Anniversary to ensure the continued impact of women giving collectively, granting strategically, and growing a greater Greenville.

How will GWG honor the SHERoes?

In the May 12 issue of the *Greenville Journal*, there will be a full page listing every SHERo and the person who is honoring or memorializing her. For example, **Susan Smith**, honored by *Alice Smith*

For each SHERo you recognize, we will send a card informing her (or a designee) of this recognition made in her honor.

What do I need to do to honor a SHERo?

A minimum donation of \$50 to the GWG Endowment by April 15 will allow you to honor one SHERo. There’s no limit to how many women you can honor – and you can honor them year after year!

Is honoring a SHERo limited to GWG members?

No. Any woman or man who wishes to honor a SHERo can participate.
